



## Electric Pallet Jack

The unit is steered with a lever which also acts as a pump handle to raise the jack. The forks can be lowered back down to the ground by relying on the tiny handle situated on the tiller. This handle releases hydraulic fluid when it is activated. The forks are situated on levers and there are front wheels found on the inside end of the forks. The levers are attached to specific linkages that have their own levers uniting with a cylinder. The hydraulic jack raises at the end with this system as the links force the wheels down. The forks subsequently raise vertically above the front wheels to raise the load up past the floor. To maintain safety, the pallet is only raised high enough to clear the floor for travel. Typically, pallet jacks have steering wheels located in the front and each fork often comes with a single or double wheel configuration.
